

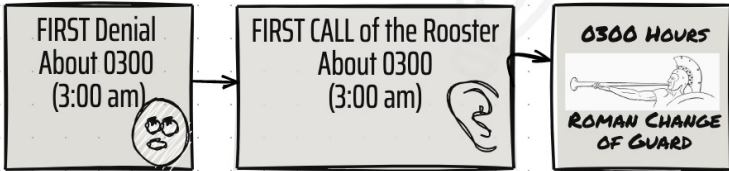
# Peter's Denials of Yeshua

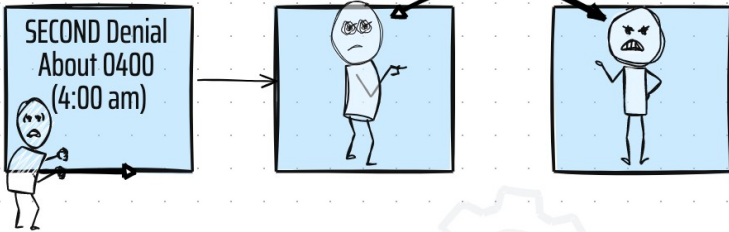

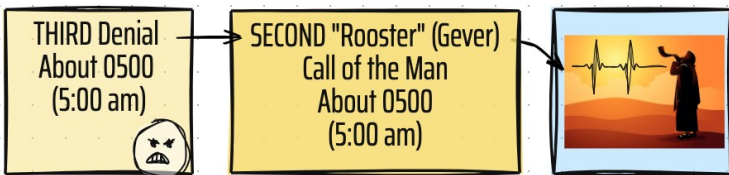

EVENT 15:

FIRST DENIAL - overnight about 0300 hours

Luke 22:55-57. Peter sat among them. And a certain servant girl, seeing him as he sat by the fire, looked intently at him and said, "This man was also with Him." But he denied Him, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him."

Mark 14:66-68. One of the servant girls of the high priest came, and when she saw Peter warming himself, she looked at him and said, "You also were with Yeshua of Nazareth." But he denied him, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are saying."

FIRST ROOSTER CROW - about 0300 hours - Roman Trumpeter and change of the Roman guard  
Mark 14:68. And he went out on the porch, and a rooster crowed.

EVENT 16:

SECOND DENIAL - about 0400 hours

Luke 22:58. And after a little while, another saw him and said, "You also are of them." But Peter said, "Man, I am not!"

Mark 14:69-70. And the servant girl saw him again and began to say to those who stood by, "This is one of them." But he denied it again.

EVENT 17:

THIRD DENIAL - about 0500 - 0600 hours

Luke 22:59-60. Then after about an hour had passed, another confidently affirmed, saying, "Surely this fellow also was with Him, for he is a Galilean." But Peter said, "Man, I do not know what you are saying!"

Mark 14:70-71. And a little later, those who stood by said to Peter again, "Surely you are one of them; for you are a Galilean, and your speech shows." Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know this Man of whom you speak!"

SECOND ROOSTER CROW: about 0500 - 0600 hours Judean Call of the Rooster in the Temple

Luke 22:60. Immediately, while he was still speaking, the rooster crowed.

Mark 14:72. A second time, the rooster crowed.

B. Talmud Tamid 26a. Among the members of the priestly family who are to serve in the Temple that day, whoever wants to remove the ashes from the altar rises early and immerses himself in a ritual bath, as required of anyone who enters the Temple courtyard... And at what time does the appointed priest arrive? The times of his arrival are not all the same. There are times that he comes at the call of the rooster [hagever], or he might come at an adjacent time, either before the call of the rooster or after it.

EVENT 18

Luke 22:61-62. And the Master turned and looked at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word of the Master, how He had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." So, Peter went out and wept bitterly.
